BRIGHTON & HOVE A PRIME UK LOCATION

Brighton is the ideal place to study during the Summer. With over 8 million visitors, Brighton and Hove is one of the most popular seaside resorts in the UK and is in the top 10 UK destinations for overseas visitors. It is located on the south coast of England, 50 minutes by train from London and with easy access to international airports (Gatwick is 30 minutes by train and Heathrow 1½ hours by car). The College is close to the local bus routes and 5 minutes from the train station.

Although the weather in Brighton (like the rest of Britain) is variable, Sussex enjoys more hours of sunshine annually than anywhere else in the UK. Average daytime temperatures range from 20 - 25c in Summer. Brighton is a unique mixture of beach, city and countryside and there are always plenty of things to see and do throughout the year but especially during the Summer months when you can join in the many festivals and events taking place in the city or just relax with friends on the beach.



City College Brighton and Hove is excellently located in the heart of Brighton, just 10 minutes walk to the seafront where you'll find stylish bars, cafés and restaurants along with surfer shops and artists studios. The city is internationally known for its nightlife and DJ's and clubbers will travel from far for a night out in the city.

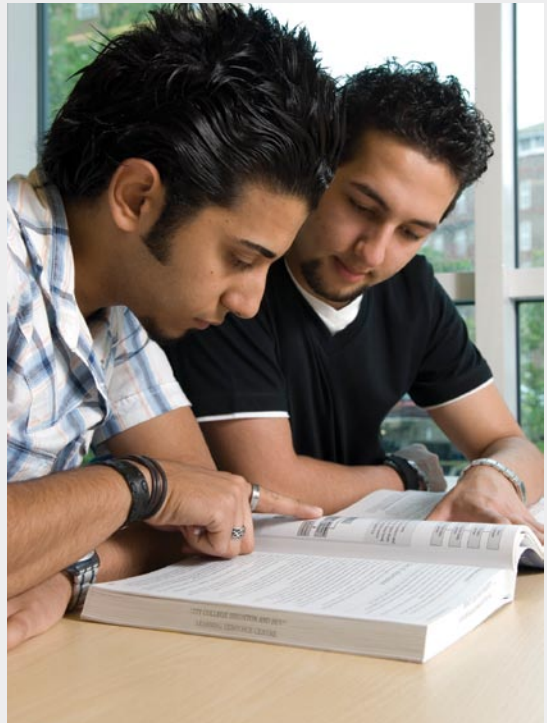

Send your application form with a deposit of either £1,000 or your full tuition fees. All fees must be paid in full on or before your first day. If you require a tier 4 student visa we will issue you with a CAS when we have received your payment.

We will send you details of your homestay accommodation when we have received the £50 accommodation arrangement fee.

You will also be sent further information and advice before you start your course at City College Brighton and Hove.
